

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

PGE BARCELONA, S.L. ("PGE") is a Spanish commercial company domiciled at c/ Roc Boronat No. 147 Floor 10 08018 Barcelona, with email address paugasolacademy@paugasol.com, Tax ID B19765866 and registered in the Commercial Registry of Barcelona, sheet number 620396. PGE is the owner of all intellectual property rights or any other type over the website (hereinafter, "Website"), whose access and use by users (hereinafter, "User" or "Users") is subject to these terms of use (hereinafter, "Terms of Use") and will be complemented by any other legal texts that regulate any functionality, service, process, application, platform or means necessary for the use of the Website or connected to it.

Please read the Terms of Use carefully. The fact of accessing the Website and using the materials contained therein implies that you have read and accept, without any reservation, these Terms of Use. If you do not agree with all or part of these Terms of Use, the User must refrain from using the Website.

2. PURPOSE

The Website contains material prepared by PGE for informational purposes only. The user should note that such material may not reflect the most recent legislative or jurisprudential status on the issues analyzed. Likewise, PGE reserves the right to modify, expand or reduce the material offered through the Website at any time, informing Users of this.

The parties waive any claim for damages that could be requested for this circumstance.

12. APPLICABLE LAW AND COMPETENT JURISDICTION

Access to the Website implies acceptance by the User of the provisions of these Terms of Use. If you do not agree with these Terms of Use, please refrain from visiting or using the Website. Any dispute relating to them will be governed by common Spanish law, with the parties expressly waiving the jurisdiction that corresponds to them, and submitting to the Courts and Tribunals of the city of Barcelona (Spain). If you are a consumer, the courts of your domicile in Spain will have exclusive jurisdiction.

13. REFUND/REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

13.1 - Right of withdrawal

You, as the parent/mother/guardian who has requested the participant's registration, have the right to cancel your registration at the Academy campus in any of its modalities during the 14 calendar days following the registration date.

Communication of the right of withdrawal: You must communicate this to us in writing, for which a "WITHDRAWAL FORM" is provided at the end of these terms, although its use is not mandatory. Such communication will be valid provided it is sent within the aforementioned period, and you do not need to indicate the reason for your withdrawal. Please note that if you are not the parent/mother/guardian who requested the participant's registration, we may need additional information to process your withdrawal request.

Refund: In case of cancellation, the request will be evaluated by the Academy organization and resolved individually according to the sections established below. Any situation not expressly contemplated will be considered a particular case and will be analyzed specifically by the organization, which will communicate the corresponding resolution to the interested party.

In all cases of approved refunds, a deduction of twenty euros (€20) will be applied for administrative processing costs.

13.2 - Cancellation of participation

In addition to the right of withdrawal that you have, as the parent/mother/guardian who has paid the amount, you will also have, depending on when you communicate it to us and the reason or justification for it, the possibility of canceling your child's participation. In any case, twenty euros (€20) will also be deducted from the amount paid for administrative processing costs. Please note that if you are not the parent/mother/guardian who made the payment, we may need additional information to process your cancellation request.

If you prove that the cancellation is due to a medical reason, a higher amount will be refunded than if you cancel your attendance without a medical reason.

For these purposes, it will be an essential requirement to present a medical certificate advising the participant not to attend the Academy's basketball program due to their physical or health condition. In all cases, twenty euros (€20) will be deducted from the amount to be refunded for administrative processing costs. Thus:

→ With medical certificate:

- Cancellations until May 1: 80% of the total amount will be refunded.
- Cancellations until June 1: 50% of the total amount will be refunded.

- Cancellations from June 2 until the day the campus starts: 25% of the total amount will be refunded.
- Cancellations once the campus has started: no amount will be refunded.

→ **Without medical certificate:**

- Cancellations until March 30: 50% of the total amount will be refunded.
- Cancellations until April 30: 25% of the total amount will be refunded.
- Cancellations from May 1: no amount will be refunded.

→ **PGA Family Experience:**

- Cancellations until April 1: 50% of the total amount will be refunded.
- Cancellations from April 2: No amount will be refunded.

Communication of program participation cancellation:

Refunds that are not due to the exercise of the right of withdrawal must be requested in writing, sending to paugasolacademy@paugasol.com the form included below, together with any documentation considered relevant. To determine the date on which the request was sent, the date of sending by email will be taken into account.

Refund: The refund of the resulting amount in cases of cancellation provided for in this section will be made effective from the end date of the basketball program in which the participant was enrolled.

13.3 - Basic information on data protection

The data controller is PGE BARCELONA, S.L. which will process the personal data provided to manage your request, whose basis of legitimacy is the execution of the contractual relationship that you have accepted to be part of by subscribing to the PGA registration form. To manage the request, your data will not be transferred to third parties, except legal obligation. You may exercise your rights of access, rectification and deletion of data, as well as other rights at any time. Without medical certificate: ·Cancellations until June 1: 90% of the amount paid will be refunded. ·Cancellations from June 2 to June 13: 60% of the amount paid will be refunded. ·Cancellations from June 14: 20% of the amount paid will be refunded. ·Cancellations once the campus has started: No amount will be refunded.
